### NOTE REGARDING ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES:

The ZSuite Enrollment database is Open for enrollments for the 2024-2025 4-H Program Year *The database* is designed that your form is in Pending Approval Status until the Club Leader receives the **Enrollment Fee** for Youth is \$95—payable to your 4-H Club via Check or Cash and for Project Leaders it is \$28 (some 4-H clubs pay the leader's enrollment fee—Check with the 4-H Community Club Leader).

The 4-H Community Club Leader then Notifies the 4-H Office Program Assistant that the Fee has been paid and it is at that time the Youth are Activated. Volunteers have additional requirements.
