The ZSuite Enrollment database is Open for enrollments for the 2024-2025 4-H Program Year

Please Make sure that you are Including the Youth's GRADE in the Enrollment form! - SEE PAGE 5!

The database is designed that your form is in Pending Approval Status until the Club Leader receives the **Enrollment Fee for Youth is \$95—payable to your 4-H Club via Check or Cash** and for Project Leaders it is \$28 (some 4-H clubs pay the leader's enrollment fee—Check with the 4-H Community Club Leader).

- 2. Locate youth member and click UPDATE ENROLLMENT or CONTINUE ENROLLMENT.
- 3. Scroll to the School Information section and verify/update the grade selection.
- 4. Scroll to the bottom and click SUBMIT CHANGES.




