As most of you are aware, last year was the first year the counties used the New Club and County Record Book Evaluation sheets. When it came to County Record Book Judging Day, we knew that after last year's event we were going to have to adjust how we have traditionally done County Level Record Book Judging.

This year's County Level Record Book Judging will be a full two-day event. We will do all the record book evaluations downstairs in the UCCE Auditorium. Because there were significant obstacles last year, we all need to be in one place. I will be able to better oversee the entire process, as everyone will be in small groups. We will set-up Table Groups around the room – and since the requirement from the State 4-H Office is that each Record Book Evaluator act independently there should not be an issue with noise.

Because the new Evaluation Form is so different from what we are used to, everyone who signs up to judge record books at the County Level **MUST have participated in a club level record book evaluations/judging process**. Unfortunately, our time is limited, and the new process takes longer to judge and process each record book submitted. Prior Club Level Record Book judging experience will be very important for each person, in order for us to be able to judge and process all record books submitted within this two-day time frame - September 7th and 8th.

This will be a different process than we are used to, and I hope we are able to get a good turnout of club level experience Judges for County Record Book Judging Days.

Here are the requirements:

Must have judged Record Books at the Club Level

Must be able to stay for the entire day – RSVP which day you can Judge on: 9/7 or 9/8 2018

Must have either attended last year's Record Book Training (the office has the sign-up sheet) or attend this year's training on Thursday, August 23, 2018 from 7pm – 9pm.

A nice Panera lunch will be provided each day.

Pre-registration/RSVPs will be required as the Auditorium has limited space, and we will need to make sure we have a balanced number of Judges signed up for either one of the days.

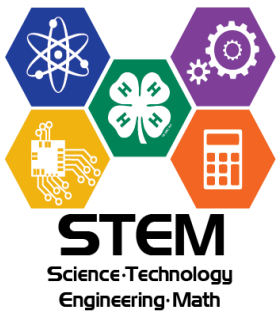

The San Luis Obispo County 4-H Management Board is happy to offer **three (3) Life Skills scholarships** in the amount of **\$300 each**. **The Scholarship Application Areas are:**

- 1. Citizenship/Community Service**
- 2. Leadership**
- 3. Life Skills**

If you are a current 4-H member who is in good standing in SLO County who is planning to attend college this Fall, you are eligible to apply for all three of these scholarships; however, you will be awarded only one scholarship. In addition to general 4-H and academic information, the applicant is asked to address the following:

Citizenship/Community Service:

1. What types of citizenship/community service involvement did you participate in during your 4-H career?
2. Describe two or three citizenship/community service activities that were most significant to you. Explain how you think your citizenship/community service activities will influence your life in the future.

Leadership:

1. What leadership skills have you developed through your 4-H career and how were they developed?
2. Describe how you think your leadership skills will influence your life in the future.

Life Skills:

1. What life skills have you developed through your 4-H career and how were they developed?
2. Describe how you think these life skills will influence your life in the future.

Come watch our SLO County 4-H Horse Project riders compete at the Mid State Fair horse show on Friday July 21st. The show will be happening all day, with english riding in the morning, followed by western riding and then gymkhana in the afternoon.

California 4-H Horse Classic

Our SLO County riders and their project horses performed wonderfully at the 2017 California State 4-H Horse Classic June 21-25 at the Murieta Equestrian Center in Rancho Murieta. The state show offers 4-H members the chance to showcase the culmination of their efforts put into in their equine projects throughout the year.

Payton Ansite and Pokey from Creston 4-H rocked the over fences show, placing 1st in both of the 2'6" equitation classes, earning a clover medal, and placing 4th in both jumpers and working hunters.

Julia Rey and Jimmie from Templeton 4-H placed 1st in Junior Western showmanship and equitation, 2nd in Western Pleasure, 4th in horsemanship and trail. Julia earned Western Reserve Champion Junior for California!

Two Nipomo 4-H riders competed in both the Western and Gymkhana shows. Lacey Andrews and Mistress placed 8th in Junior Western showmanship, 5th in equitation, 4th in western pleasure, 6th in the open western riding class, and 3rd in open reining, earning a clover medal. At the Gymkhana show Lacey and Mistress earned 2nd place in quadrangle and 3rd place in birangle, speed barrels, cloverleaf barrels, and Washington poles in the Junior division.

Shayna Andrews rode Reno in the Senior division for the Western show, placing 3rd in the open western riding class, and riding a fantastic reining pattern! Shayna rode her second project horse, Chickadee, in the Senior division Gymkhana, placing 1st in cloverleaf barrels, 2nd in birangle, quadrangle, speed barrels, and Washington poles; and 3rd in single stake. Shayna is our Champion Senior Gymkhana rider for California 4-H!
