## 2021 SOD BLITZ

### May 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>

Due to the direction and guidance from the CDPH on COVID-19 and social distancing the community meeting/training sessions <u>will not be held</u> but instead there is an <u>online training</u> for this years SOD BLITZ at www.sodblitz.org.

Currently the tree disease Sudden Oak Death (SOD) is found in 16 counties and is currently found at the Monterey/San Luis Obispo County border. Early detection on bay laurel is key, before the infection of oaks and tanoaks, for a successful proactive attempt to slow down the SOD epidemic. SOD infected oaks can also burn very hot, increasing fire intensity around them.

In 2020, the aggressive EU1 strain of *P.* ramorum was found for the first time in Del Norte County and its pivotal we know if this strain is elsewhere! In 2019, *P. ramorum* has been found in three streams (not on landscape vegetation) in San Luis Obispo County, so continuing to sampling bay laurel is critical.
