2021 SOD BLITZ May 15th, 16th & 17th

The tree disease Sudden Oak Death (SOD) is killing millions of oaks in California and Oregon with the southernmost known location at the Monterey/San Luis Obispo County border. <u>Early detection on bay laurel trees</u>, before the infection of oaks and tanoaks is key to slowing the SOD epidemic. SOD-infected oaks can also burn very hot, increasing fire intensity around them.

In 2020, the aggressive EU1 strain of the SOD pathogen (*Phytophthora ramorum*) was found for the first time in northern County and its pivotal we know if this strain is elsewhere! In 2019, *P. ramorum* has been found in <u>3 streams</u> in San Luis Obispo County but not on plants, so continuing to sampling bay laurel is critical.

Each person is required to take a short training in order to participate in the SOD BLITZ, and due to state and local COVID restrictions, the training is provided online. Additional COVID guidelines are provided on the training page.
