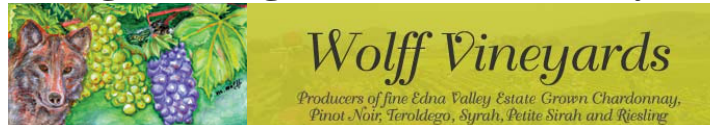

“Ecological Programs at Wolff Vineyards”



Learn about the many ecological programs that are part of this vineyard’s approach to sustainable winegrowing and land stewardship. Planted 30 years ago, the vineyard (<http://www.wolffvineyards.com>) is located on 125 acres of ecologically friendly property in Edna Valley just minutes from downtown San Luis Obispo. Committed to maintaining and improving the ecology of their vineyard, the Wolff family restores and manages habitat for wildlife such as quail, American Kestrels, Red-tailed Hawks, Barn Owls, native pond turtles, and creek fish. This winegrowing operation has been certified sustainable by Sustainability in Practice (SIP)TM (<http://www.sipthegoodlife.org>), a vineyard and winemaker certification program developed by the Central Coast Vineyard Team (CCVT, <http://www.vineyardteam.org>).
