- Northbound – Take Exit 239A, bear right onto Mission St for 0.8 mi
- Southbound – Take Exit 239, turn left onto 10th St for 0.2 mi, left onto Mission St for 0.4 mi
- Turn 2nd right onto River Rd for 0.6 mi
- Turn left onto Cross Canyons Rd for 0.1 mi
- Turn 1st left onto Indian Valley Rd for 1.4 mi
- Bear right onto Vineyard Canyon Rd for ~21 mi
- Turn left onto Parkfield Coalinga Rd for 0.4 mi
